We especially enjoyed a visit from Dr. Lockwood who showed us different fossils and talked about the dinosaur he discovered called






We have enjoyed our Dinosaur topic this half term, using it to develop our skills in all areas of our learning. We are now ready to learn and develop our skills further.

Mathematics



We will also start to identify subtraction facts by taking objects away and counting how many are left.


Our topics this half term: Billions of Books!
