
Dear Parents and Carers,

English

Our main text for this half term is The Stone Age Boy by Satoshi Kitamura. We will use this as a basis for much or our written work, including story writing, instructions and report writing.

Mathematics

There will be a big focus on understanding place value, particularly in three-digit numbers. This will be alongside number patterns. We are also working hard on problem solving and reasoning skills, as well as being able to explain our thinking. We will also be securing knowledge and understanding of addition and subtraction.

Any practise at home to secure knowledge of the 2, 5 and 10 times tables would be great. We will then begin to learn the 3, 4 and 8 times tables this year.

Curriculum

This term we start the year with a History topic, which is finding out about life during the Stone, Bronze and Iron Ages. We will be looking at the changes that took place during these periods of time, and the significant features of them. As part of our Design & Technology unit on 'structures', we will be planning and making some 3D shapes using nets, and using the features of Stone, Bronze and Iron Age dwellings for inspiration. The children will also start learning French this year too.


Science
