

Curriculum Leaflet

English

Activities based on the Romans. We will be writing our own non-chronological reports and diary entries.

Mathematics

Measure- measuring, comparing, adding and subtracting volume (I and mI)

Multiplication and division- a focus on the 3,4 and 8 times tables, using known facts

Geometry- naming, sorting, classifying and describing 2D and 3D shapes.

Science

We will be learning about rocks and soils. We will be comparing different rocks and soils and carrying out practical investigations to answer questions such as 'Are all soils permeable?' We will also be learning about the formation of fossils.
