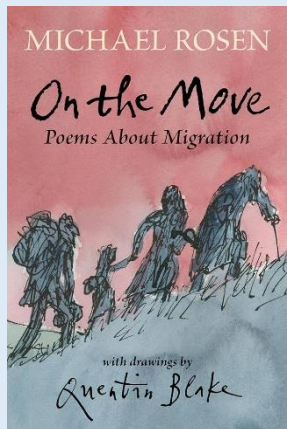
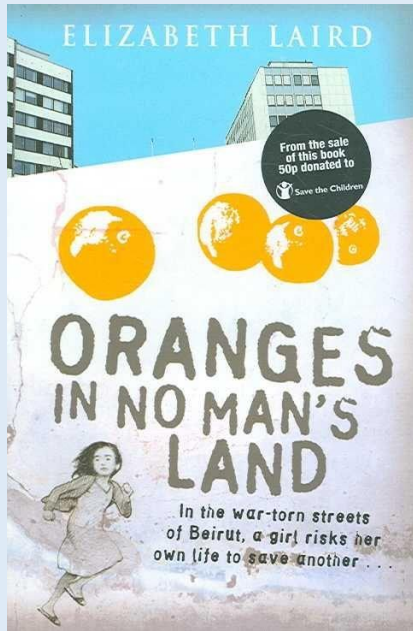

Our writing will be inspired by the books 'The Island and 'Oranges in No Man's Land' which are both on the theme of refugees and migration. We will be writing newspaper reports, persuasive speeches and monologues.

We will be reading 'Oranges in No Man's Land' by Elizabeth Laird as well as exploring a collection of poems by Michael Rosen called 'On the Move'.

There will also be a weekly spelling and grammar focus.

Mathematics
