We will, of course, inform you once it is safe to do so Via Class Dojo or Email. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to get in touch.

Finally, a reminder that ONLY fruit is allowed as a snack for break times please. We are starting to see sugary snacks, crisps and all sorts of 'not fruit' snacks. I have spoken to the children about this in assembly today too, so they all know. Thank you for your support with this.
