#### AGE 1 - 3 YEARS (Boy or girl) CHOOSE FROM

Small soft toy, picture book, hat, gloves, socks, soap, hairbrush, flannel, toothbrush and toothpaste, plus any other suitable small items.

#### AGE 4 - 7 YEARS (Boy or girl) CHOOSE FROM

Pictorial educational book and game, simple jigsaw, ball, lego, cravons and colouring book. hat, gloves, scarf, socks, soap, hairbrush, flannel, toothbrush and toothpaste, toy vehicle, small doll, skipping rope.

#### AGE 8 - 11 YEARS (Boy or girl) CHOOSE FROM

Pictorial educational book and game, jigsaw, ball, card game, felt tip pens, pencils, pencil case, drawing book, hat, gloves, scarf, socks, wide toothed comb, soap, flannel, toothbrush and toothpaste, sports item, skipping rope, hair accessories.

#### AGE 12 - 15 YEARS (Boy or girl) CHOOSE FROM

Pictorial educational book and game, playing cards, geometry set, pens, pencils and case, pencil sharpener, rubber, writing/drawing book, hat, gloves, scarf, socks, wide toothed comb. soap, flannel, toothbrush and toothpaste, washbag, hair accessories, sports item.
