Maths

Count to at least 50 forwards, beginning with 1 and backwards from 10.

- count in 10s to 50.
- find one more and one less.
- solve problems in a context, finding one more and one less.
- use objects and pictures to represent a number.
- place a number on a number line.
- · order numbers.
- can compare numbers.
- partition numbers to 5

We will be learning about materials and seasons.

We will learn:

- To identify and name a variety of everyday materials.
- Describe the simple physical properties of a variety of materials.
- Compare and group together a variety of materials based on simple physical properties.

We will also be finding out about the scientist Ole Kirk Christinsen who invented Lego.









Phonics

We will be revisiting the phase 3 and 4 sounds the child learned in reception this half term to make sure they are secure in in these sounds before beginning phase 5 after half term.

- mixing primary colours to make secondary colours.
- Experimenting adding black and white to colours
- Make an painting using warm and cool colours.

Geography

 our feelings and emotions linked to the zones of regulation.


Music
