
# Curriculum Leaflet Welcome to Year 3! September 2024



#### Welcome back!

The children have settled well into their new year group and have been working hard.

In English, we are looking at Stone Age Boy by Satoshi Kitamura. We have collected some great ideas for our writing so far and I'm looking forward to seeing how the children use them in their writing.

### Year 3 Autumn Term 1 2024

#### **English**

Activities based on Stone Age Boy including rewriting the story and instructions

We will be doing whole class reading sessions 3 times a week as well as spelling and handwriting.

#### **Mathematics**

Number- The place value of 3 digit numbers and different ways to represent them

Calculation- Recalling facts to 20 and 100, comparing numbers, adding and subtracting 3 digit numbers and single digit numbers, addition and subtraction with money and length

Daily times table practice

#### Science

We will be learning about Light. We will be focusing on reflective materials, shadows and protecting ourselves from the sun. We will also learn about Thomas Edison.
