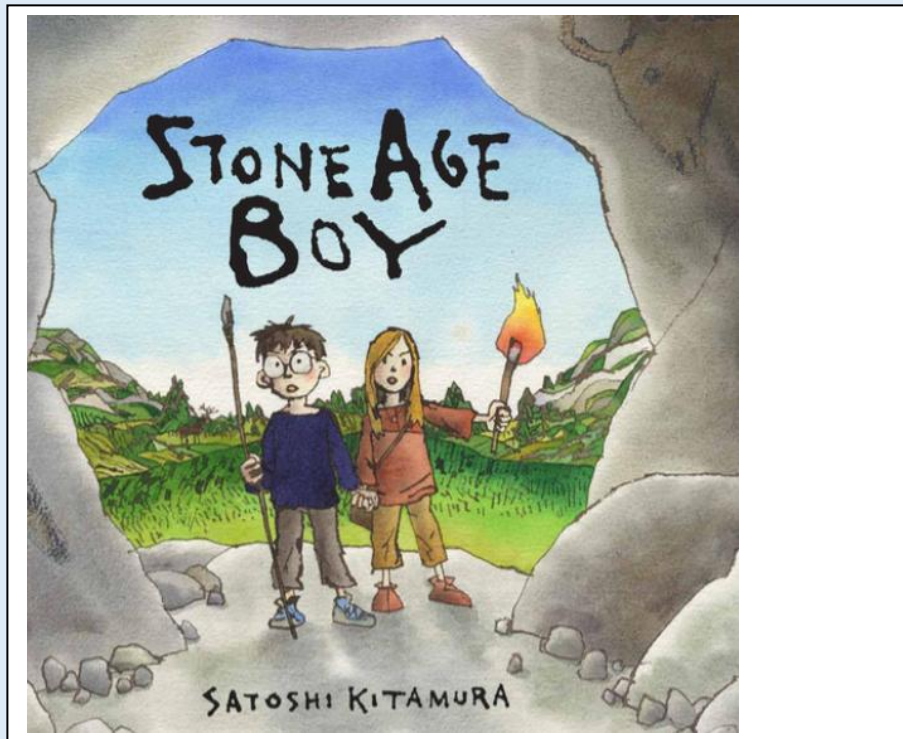


## Curriculum Leaflet

### Autumn Term 1



***Welcome back!***

***It has been lovely seeing the children after the summer holidays. They have made a great start to Year 3!***

In English, we are using Stone Age Boy by Satoshi Kitamura. We will spend time thinking about effective vocabulary and how we can link ideas before using them in our own writing.



## English

Activities based on Stone Age Boy including rewriting the story and instructions.

We will be doing whole class reading sessions 3 times a week as well as spelling and handwriting.

The children will also continue with their Little Wandle group reading in the afternoons.

## Mathematics

Number- place value of 3-digit numbers and different ways to represent them.

Calculation- recalling facts to 20 and 100, comparing numbers, adding and subtracting 3-digit numbers and single digit numbers, addition and subtraction of money and length

Daily times table practise

## Science

We will be learning about light. We will be focusing on reflective materials, shadows and protecting ourselves from the sun. We will also learn about Thomas Edison.
