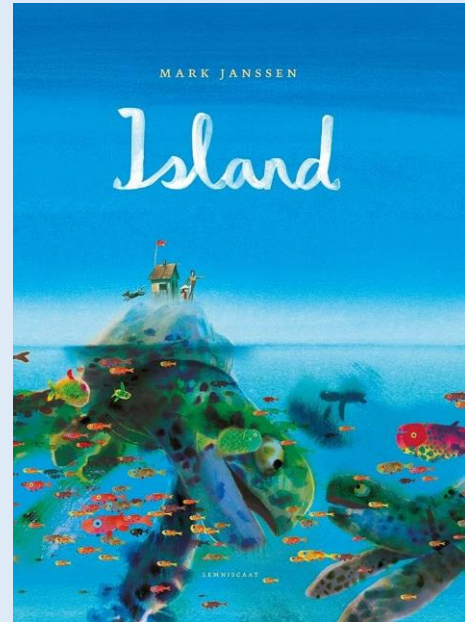
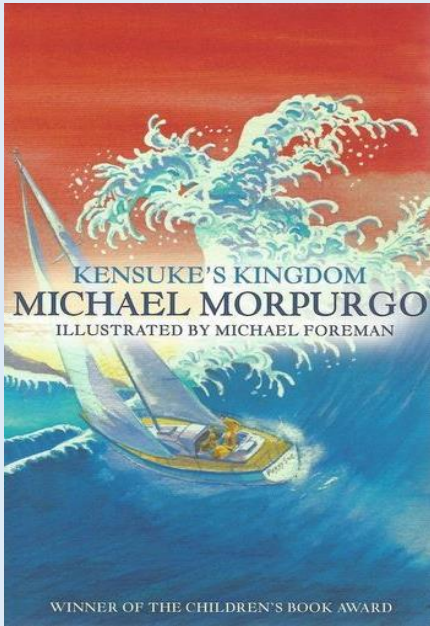


Binstead Primary School Curriculum **Information**

English

Our class novel is 'Kensuke's Kingdom' by Michael Morpurgo. We will complete daily reading tasks to deepen our understanding of the text.

Our writing will be inspired by 'Kensuke's Kingdom' as well as a beautiful picture book, 'Island' by Mark Janssen. We will be focusing on descriptions, narratives and diaries.

There will also be a weekly spelling and grammar focus.

Mathematics

The areas will cover this half-term are:

- Number and place value (comparing, ordering, rounding)
- Addition and subtraction
- Perimeter
- Multiplication and division
- Fractions

We will have a weekly arithmetic lesson where we focus on fluency with the four operations and have a weekly times table test.
