
Binstead Primary School Curriculum Information

We will be reading an abridged version of 'The Tempest' and enjoying the novel 'The Stormkeeper's Island' by Catherine Doyle.

There will also be a weekly spelling and grammar focus.

Mathematics

We will have a weekly arithmetic lesson where we focus on the four operations and a weekly times table test.
