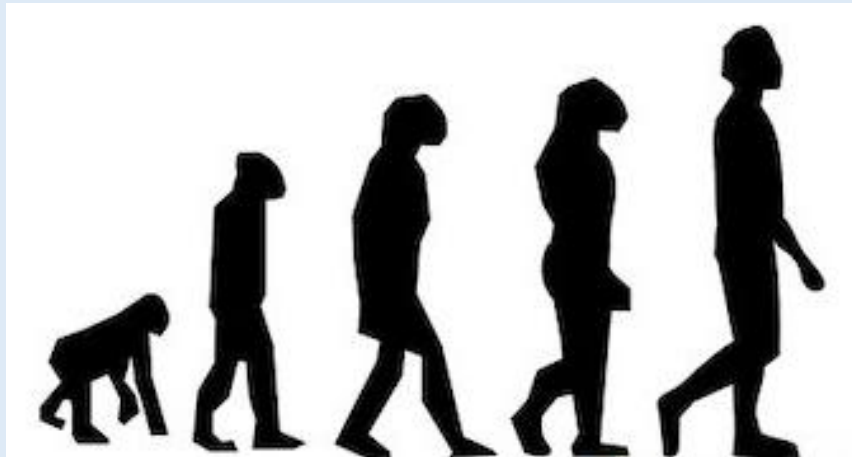
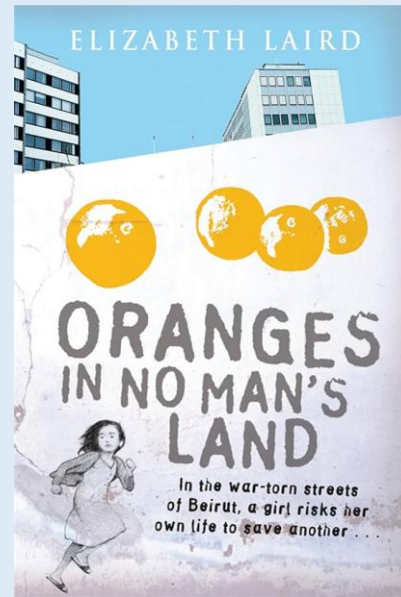

English

Our writing will be inspired by a wonderful film clip, 'Pandora Discovered' and an inspiring novel by Elizabeth Laird, 'Oranges in No Man's Land.'

We will use 'Oranges in No Man's Land' for our reading focus as well as a range of linked non-fiction and poetry texts.

There will also be a weekly spelling and grammar focus.

Mathematics

The areas we will cover are:

- Addition and subtraction
- Algebra
- Place value revision
- Fractions revision
- Measures revision
- Fractions, decimals and percentages revision

We will have a weekly arithmetic lesson and a weekly times table test.

Science

We will finish our unit on classification before moving onto our new topic of evolution and inheritance.

We will examine the main theories of evolution and look at some of the key thinkers in the field.

We will learn about how different animals are adapted to the environments they live in.

Geography

We will be investigating energy and renewable sources.

We will use maps and atlases to identify how natural resources are distributed around the world as well as explore interactive maps of the different locations that produce energy in the UK. We will explore the school site and decide where would be the best location for a turbine or a solar panel.
